The Planning Permission proposal received in the reference cited for the construction of Ground floor residential building in Plot No.3 part, Duraisamy Road at S.No. 105/1 of Virugambakkam village was examined and found that the planning permission for the same is issuable by regularising the unauthorised sub-division subject to condition that --

- i) 'in the Open space within the site to the extent feasible trees be planted and the existing trees preserved'
- ii) 'it was requested to ensure that the plans for the new buildings will incorporate the approved designs for mosquito-proof overhead tanks and wells'
- iii) 'improvement charge, open space reservation charge and other charges as applicable'.
