The proposal received in the reference cited for the construction of Brick chamber in S.No.119 and 120 of Agraharam Village has been examined and you were requested to submit the revised plans to satisfying rules. 2. In this connection, you are requested to remit a sum of Rs.8,600/- + Rs.3,000/- = Rs.11,600/- (Rupees Eleven thousand and six hundred only) towards Development charges for land and building and Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred only) towards Scrutiny fees by a Demand draft of any nationalised Bank in Madras, drawn in favour of the Member-Secretary, MMDA and the same may be remitted at the cash counter of the MMDA within ten days on receipt of this letter. You are also requested to furnish an undertaking deed duly notarised and two copies of plan duly signed by Licensed Surveyor and owner.

3. On receipt of the amount, the approved plans will be sent to the Commissioner, Poonamallee Panchayat Union for further action.
