Planning permission application will be returned unapproved if the amount are not paid within the stipulated time. (X) Perungudi

3. On receipt of the amount, the approved plans will be sent to the Commissioner/Executive Officer/Township/Town Panchayat/Sanchayat Union/Municipality/Corporation of Madras for further action.
