The Planning Permission Application received in the reference cited for the construction of Ground + 3 Floors Residential building with 13 dwellings in Door No. 44, 1st Main Road, Kamraj Avenue, T.C. No. 89/2, Block No. 9 of Pallipattu Village has been approved subject to the conditions incorporated in the reference 5th cited.

2. The applicant has remitted the following charges in Challan No. 62394 dated 9-11-'94. Accepting the conditions stipulated by MOLDA vide in the reference 4th cited and furnished Bank Guarantee for a sum of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand only) towards Security Deposit for building which is valid upto 31-10-1999.

3. As per the Madras Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board letter cited in the reference 6th cited with reference to the sewerage system the promoter has to submit the necessary sanitary application directly to Metro Water and only after due sanction he can commence the internal sewer works.

4. In respect of water supply, it may be possible for Metro Water to extend water supply to a single pump for the above premises for the purpose of drinking and cooking only and confined to 5 persons per dwelling at the rate of 10 lpcd. In respect of requirements of water for other uses, the promoter has to ensure that he can make alternate arrangements. In this case also, the promoter should apply for the water connection after approval of the sanitary proposal and internal works should be taken up only after the approval of the water application. It shall be ensured that all wells, overhead tanks and Septic Tanks are hermetically sealed with proper protection to avoid mosquito menace.

4. Two copy/set of approved plans, numbered as Planning Permit No. B/13382/527/Atm/94 dated 05-12-'94 are sent herewith. The Planning Permit is valid for the period from 5-12-'94 to 4-12-'97.
