The planning permission application mentioned in the
reference cited for the proposed construction of Ground +
2 Floor Residential Building for 3 Dwelling Units at Plot
No. 39, Door No. 7, 3rd Cross Street, Venkatesapuram Colony
in S.No. 154/1, T.S. No. 60, Block No. 34 of Ayavaram Village
has been approved subject to the conditions incorporated in
the reference second cited.

2. The applicant has remitted the necessary charges in
Challan No. 100008, dated 5.8.98 accepting the conditions
stipulated by CMIA vice in the reference third cited.

3. The applicant has furnished a Demand Draft in favour
of Managing Director, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and
Sewerage Board for a sum of Rs. 43,300/- (Rupees forty three
thousand and three hundred only) towards Water Supply and
Sewerage Infrastructure Development Charges in his letter
dated 12.8.98. With reference to the sewage system the
promoter has to submit the necessary sanitary application
directly to Metro water and only after the sanction he/she can
commence the internal sewer works.

In respect of water supply, it may be possible for
Metro water to extend water supply to a single unit for the
above premises for the purpose of drinking and cooking only
and confined to 6 persons per dwelling at their rate of 10 feet.
In respect of requirements of water for other uses, the
promoter has to ensure that he/she can make alternate arrange-
ments. In this case also, the promoter should apply for the
water connection, no offer approval of the sanitary proposal and
internal works should be taken up only after the approval of
the water application. It shall be ensured that all wells,
overhead tanks and septic tanks are hermetically sealed off with
properly protected roofs to avoid mosquito menace.

4. Two copies/sets of approved plans numbered as Planning
Permit No. 5/2017 U 227/98, dated 29.10.98 are sent herewith.
The Planning Permit is valid for the period from 29.10.1998 to
19.10.2001.

5. This approval is not final. The applicant has to
approach the Chennai Corporation for issue of Building Permit

The following table shows the correlation coefficient calculated by
method of Spearman, between age and each of the following:
- the number of errors (true because wrong) per hundred questions
- total age of incorrect responses per hundred questions
- average age of incorrect responses per hundred questions
- average age of correct responses per hundred questions
- average age of responses with a single error per hundred questions
- average age of responses with two or more errors per hundred questions
