2. The Planning Permission Application would be returned unapproved, if the payment is not made within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.

This amount of interest shall be remitted along with the charges due.

4. You are also requested to comply with the following:

5. The issue of Planning Permission will depend on the compliance/fulfilment of the conditions/payments stated above.
