The Planning Permission Application and Revised Plan received in the reference 1st cited for the construction proposed construction of Office Complex Stilt+3 Floors at Plot No.B-21, New Door No.56, 1st Avenue, Ashok Nagar, T.S.No.117/2, Block No.52 of Kodambakkam, Chennai has been approved subject to the conditions incorporated in the reference.

2. The applicant has accepted to the conditions stipulated by CMDA vide in the reference 2nd cited and has remitted the necessary charges in Challan No.B-23511, dated 13-08-2003 including Security Deposit for building Rs.40,000/- (Rupees forty thousand only) and Security Deposit for Display Board of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in cash.

3. a) The applicant has furnished a demand draft in favour of Managing Director, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board, for a sum of Rs.51,000/- (Rupees fifty one thousand only) towards Water Supply and Sewerage Infrastructure Improvement charges in his letter dated 12-08-2003.

b) With reference to the sewerage system the promoter has to submit the necessary sanitary application directly to Metro Water and only after due sanction he can commence the internal sewer works.

c) In respect of water supply, it may be possible for Metro Water to extend water supply to a single sump for the above premises for purpose of drinking and cooking only and confined to 5 persons per dwelling at the rate of 10 lpcd. In respect of requirement of water for other uses, the promoter has to ensure that he can make alternate arrangements. In this case also, the promoter should apply for the water connection, after approval of the sanitary proposal and internal works should be taken up only after the approval of the water application. It shall be ensured that all wells, overhead tanks and septic tanks are hermetically sealed off with properly protected vents to avoid mosquito menace.

4. Non provision of Rain Water Harvest structures as shown in the approved plans to the satisfaction of the Authority will be also be considered as a deviation to the approved plans and violation of Development Control Rules and enforcement action will be taken against such development.

5. Two copies/sets of approved plans numbered as B/Spl.Bldg./880/2003, dated 26-08-2003 are sent herewith. The Planning Permit is valid for the period from 26-08-2003 to 25-08-2006.

6. This approval is not final. The applicant has to approach the Chennai Corporation for issue of building permit under the Local Body Act, only after which the proposed construction can be commenced.
