Date CD/2003 - Planning Permission - Multi-storeyed Building - Proposed additional construction of 4th to 8th Floor (Block-I) over earlier approved CP+CF and subsequently regularized Commercial cum Residential Building at T.O. No. 24/2, Block No. 30, KCD Thiruvananthapuram - Chemical - Clarification called for by the Government - Sent - Regarding.

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Inviting kind attention to the letter cited 3rd in the reference, the following Remarks are offered.

2. i) Structural stability of any building comes under the purview of Local Body, in this case, Chemical Corporation under NCC Act. In this case, the plans have been sent to Chemical Corporation for their remarks. The Chief Engineer, Chemical Corporation, who is a member of the Multi-storeyed Building Panel, in the letter cited 3rd in the reference have issued the No objection Certificate for the proposed additional construction.

ii) The stability of the structure in respect of additional construction over an earlier approved building is ensured by obtaining structural stability certificate from a licensed structural engineer. In this case also, the Structural Stability Certificate alongwith design details have been obtained from the applicant.

3. i) Failure of a structure could happen due to inadequate structural design or defects in construction either due to poor quality of materials or sub-standard works are due to unplanned over loading. Structural stability can be checked by the authorities at the time of approval i.e., at the planning stage, only by obtaining the details on soil test, load calculation, details and structural stability certificate issued by a qualified structural engineer, from the applicant. These details are checked by the Chemical Corporation based on which they offer their remarks in the Multi-storeyed Building Panel.

3. iii) The failure due to defective construction method and defective materials could not be pre-checked at the planning stage and hence it is the sole responsibility of the applicant/builder/provider, to ensure stability of the construction and the safety of the occupants.

4. In view of the above, the OMC's original file No. 03/10003/2003 is forwarded to the Government with the request for suitable orders on the recommendation of the Multi-tiered Building Panel.

I am directed to invite attention to the reference cited wherein you have
requested the Government to accord approval to the recommendation of the Multi-
storeyed Building Panel for issue of Planning Permission to Thiru M. Chandru
(PCW) for the proposed (Block No.2) additional construction of 4th to 6th floor over
earlier approved 6F+SF and subsequently regularized 8F+GF+3Floors commercial
cum residential building at T.S.No.24/2, Block No.38, East Coast Road,
Thiruvanmiyur, Chennai.

2. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accord
approval to the recommendation of the Multi-storeyed Building Panel subject to

Validation of the stampings issued by Deputy Director of Fire Service in his Discretion Certificate. Accordingly, the Government approves the recommendation of the Multi-storey Building Panel for issue of Planning Permission to Thiru M. Ganesan (P116) for the proposed (Block No.1) addition construction of 4th to 8th floor over earlier approved off-set and subsequently registered SF-07-18 floors commercial and residential building at T.S.No.24/2, Block No.23, Coal Coast Road, Thiruvanmiyur, Chennai based on the plan incorporating the condition imposed by Deputy Director of Fire Service in his Discretion Certificate No C/Ho 1784103, A dated 13.4.2003.

3. I am to request you to obtain an undertaking before issue of planning permission from the applicant as used to the effect that he would fulfil all the development Control Rules provisions, conditions imposed by Deputy Director of Fire Services and other Requirements. The Chancery Ward Planning Authority is also requested to make regular inspection of the building to avoid defaults.

4. I call upon you to request you to take necessary further action accordingly for issue of planning permission and to ensure that all the conditions of Designate Director of Fire Service are carried over in the Main-stored Building.
