The members discussed in detail, the observations made by the High Court orders dated 23.08.2006, clarifications sought by the CMDA in letter dated 18.8.09 and the opinion of the Advocate General in letter dated 12.11.09. The Monitoring Committee reiterated the earlier decision on the agenda item No.3 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monitoring Committee meeting held on 10.01.07.

The following were decided:

1. All types of buildings constructed prior to 28.2.99 may be considered for regularisation irrespective of whether the application was received under 1999, 2000, 2001 or 2002 Reg. scheme and also the belated applications subsequently received, based on individual Court orders.
2. Now, Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 has been amended vide Act 61 dated 29.11.08 wherein provision is there for locking and sealing of deviated/unauthorised portions and hence Monitoring Committee decided favourably for considering individual flats also for regularisation. Any individual flat in a building constructed prior to 28.2.99 may be considered for regularisation irrespective of whether the application was received under 1999, 2000, 2001 or 2002 Reg. scheme and also in respect of the belated applications subsequently received, based on individual Court orders.
3. The plots sub-divided unauthorisedly prior to 28.2.1999 may be considered for regularisation, irrespective of whether the application was received under 1999, 2000, 2001 or 2002 Reg. scheme and also



the belated applications subsequently received, based on individual Court orders.

4. To follow the 1999 Reg. Scheme in its entirety with regard to the other norms as well as the fees for all applications considered for regularisation irrespective of whether received under 1999, 2000, 2001 or 2002 regularisation schemes.
5. M.C. also discussed the observations made by the L.F. Audit of CMDA in respect of the collection of applicable OSR charges. M.C. resolved to collect the OSR charges for the unauthorised subdivisions for the building /open plots based on the Guide Line Value of the Registration Department as prevailing on 01.07.1999.

The Committee felt that since the High Court has upheld the 1999 Reg. scheme and declared 2000, 2001 and 2002 Reg. scheme extensions as ultra vires, it may not have any objection for refund of Reg. fee for the rejected cases. However the Reg. fees have been handed over to the Govt. already. The Govt. has filed a review petition against the High Court orders dated 23.08.06

before the Hon'ble High Court. Since the outcome of the review petition filed before the Hon'ble High Court will have a bearing on the refund, the opinion of AG may be sought on the Reg.fee refund in the Reg. rejected cases.
