Today (01.06.2024), in KCBT, the Green brigade formed by the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board along with the CMDA officials & BVG Staff are inspected all the shops operating in this campus and awareness activities are carried out to the shop vendors and distributed pamphlets on plastic free zone.

Kalaignar Centenary Bus Terminus at Kilambakkam was came into operation since 30.12.2023 and is currently operating in full swing, while a large number of facilities have already been established for the benefit of the passengers, additional works are being carried out to provide a pleasant travel experience and for the safety of the passengers. A total of 41 shops including 18 restaurants, 19 snack shops and 4 miscellaneous shops are currently operational in this bus terminal. 3 - 4 tonnes of garbage are being collected daily from the KCBT premises.

In order to improve the clean operation of the bus terminal and to protect the environment, the **entire KCBT campus has been declared as a "single-use plastic free zone" from 01.05.2024**. In order to implement it, various works have been carried out for the past one month to create awareness among the Shop vendors, Employees, Transport Department Employees and the passengers. In particular, a meeting was held on 06.05.2024 and 20.05.2024 with the shop vendors and employees of the shops currently operating and awareness activities were carried out through the Tamilnadu pollution control board and the District level officials of the Food Safety Department about the banned plastic products at the campus and the alternate products that should be used.
